Together, we managed to get the Town Council to rethink plans to permanently close the toilets on Chester Road.

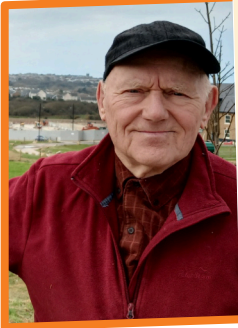
Too often, decisions aren't made with local people in mind. I was proud to support you then, and will do the same on Cornwall Council.
